All parties agree to conform to and abide by the Standards of Ethical Conduct and understand that all financial payments shall be forfeited, if the minister violates The Standards of Ethical Conduct for Ordained Officers in the Presbyterian Church (USA), in particular Section II, Paragraphs 14, 15 and 16.
- D. The minister has/has not been asked to meet with a counselor mutually agreed upon by the minister and the Committee on Ministry and paid for by the minister through the Benefits Plan of the Board of Pensions.
- E. The minister has/has not been asked to participate in a professional assessment, the cost of which shall be shared by the minister, congregation and presbytery. Failure to meet agreed upon expectations in D and E shall result in the forfeiture of unpaid financial payments.
- F. For and in consideration of the monies and other items of financial consideration, formally set out above, and for other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, minister does hereby release, acquit and discharge the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), the Synod of the Covenant, Muskingum Valley Presbytery, the church (as more fully named in first sentence of this Agreement), jointly, severally and individually, each individual member of the church, church officers presently or formerly associated or affiliated with any of the aforesaid entities in any manner, and their present and former officers, employees, attorneys, agents, personal representatives, predecessors, successors and assigns, and each of them (hereinafter collectively known as releasees) and releasees do hereby release, acquit, and discharge the minister from all claims, causes of action, suits, and injuries, known and unknown, which minister/releasees, may have had or may presently have against the minister or any of the releasees, including but not limited to any claims, causes of action, suits, injuries, damages, losses and rights arising from minister's employment by church. To the end that this mutual release shall serve to release all parties from any and all claims. It is understood that this Severance agreement is a final disposition of all matters between the minister and the releasees. This Severance agreement contains the entire agreement between the parties hereto and any representations made before or during negotiation are hereby merged in their entirety and this agreement may not be modified. The undersigned parties have negotiated this agreement in good faith and have every intention of being faithful in fulfilling it and further agree to the releases contained herein, representing that they understand its contents and sign it as their own free act after a full review of the contents.
